Directions to the Farm Site: 1107 Narrow Passage Road, Spout Spring, VA 24593

From Appomattox Courthouse: Go south on Church Street and turn left on Rt. 727 (Red House Road). Travel about 2 miles and turn right on State Rt. 604. Go 5.5 miles and turn right on Rt. 650 Narrow Passage Road. Go just over one mile and turn left into the farm.

From Concord: Go south on Rt. 24 just past the elementary school and turn left on Rt. 646. Spring Mill Road. Travel 4.2 miles and turn left onto Rt. 606 New Chapel Road. Go 2.3 miles and turn right to stay on Rt. 606. Go 0.7 miles and stay straight on Rt. 650 Narrow Passage Rd. Continue on Rt. 650 for 2.3 miles and turn into the farm on the right.
