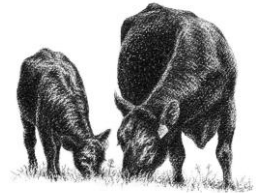

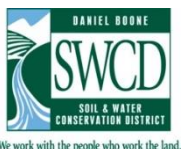
Topics will include overview of warm season species, establishment, utilization, nutrition, and how to add warm season grasses to your forage program.
