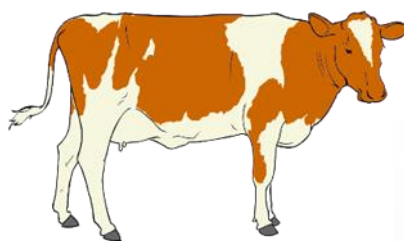


# Native Grass and Tall Fescue Pasture Walk in Patrick County
