**From Bedford:** Take VA-122 S/Burkes Hill Road south towards Moneta for about 15 miles. At the stoplight turn left onto Rt. 655/Hendricks Store Rd, and follow for 2.5 miles. When you past Radford Baptist Church, turn right onto Rt. 655/Isle of Pines Drive. Follow for just less than 1 mile and the driveway and entrance to the farm is on your left. Watch for signs as you approach the farm.

The farm is located about 30 minutes south of Bedford, 40 minutes east of Rocky Mount and 40 minutes west of Altavista and within 30 minutes' drive from Gretna.
